For a year, I have had professional experience in education primarily as an ESL teacher, and such a role has allowed me to develop a strong foundation in teaching and communication for the benefit of my students, and I also commit to community service. As such, being in the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program, I understand how to give back.

Financial Situation

I had to be independent right from my graduation. That is why I need some sort of monetary assistance to accomplish my postgraduate degree.

I work as an online ESL teacher while continuing with my studies. This job has allowed me to work from home, but the money mostly covers just the basics, and this income varies depending on whether there are bookings or not, or whether the weather is cooperative. While I will likely continue to work part-time to cover some of the costs of living, the uncertainty is that it will not be enough by itself to pay for all of the tuition, fees, and all of the materials I need to acquire to learn.

I am waiting for the opportunity for ranking in DepEd to be open and if I'm going to manage a high rank and be given an item to be eligible as a Public Teacher I hope and pray that through this I can already fund my master's degree. Since my program is online, I will stay at home, saving me some money. Additionally, I am willing to seek other forms of financial aid and work-study programs. However, this scholarship would be very crucial in reducing the financial barriers standing between me and my education, thus allowing me to pursue my studies with financial stability and focus.

Proposed Course of Study

I am pursuing a Master's Degree in Education, majoring in Social Studies, to gain more points for my ranking and qualifications. Higher points in the ranking are essential because the DepEd system requires competitive credentials to be a public school teacher. I aspire to teach in public schools because they provide the platform to reach and impact a larger, more diverse group of students, many of whom are from underserved communities.

I am particularly drawn to National Teacher's College because of its flexibility I can study even in online modalities, This program also equips me with the specialized skills to address the unique challenges faced by public school students, empowering them to become active, engaged members of their communities. and for me to not just be a competent but innovative teacher when I become a public school teacher. to add, the school's mission and Values reflect my own and that is to transform society through fulfilling their learners' professional and personal growth. If I could have these cups, I could also help my future students to be life-long learners with their observed behavioral practices.
