He is now decongesting overcrowded public junior high schools. He is now an incoming 1st year college student. He has no other support system in his family.

Despite his family's financial struggle, his family built a strong foundation for him to pursue his dreams. As such, Mark Anthony grew up to be a determined, and full of a positive outlook in life. His personality made him strong and led him now. Reaching college and knowing that he will graduate a few years from now is already a development for him. He wanted to pursue a career that fits his education once he finishes college.

III. RECOMMENDATION:
