REMARKS:

The examinee received a Full Scale IQ of (97), which places overall intellectual ability as measured by the MAB-II in the (Average) range. This Full Scale IQ is equivalent to a percentile score of (42%). The Verbal Scale IQ was (102), equivalent to a percentile of (54%), and the Performance Scale IQ was (91), equivalent to a percentile of (27%).

Test results also reveal that the examinee is likely to perform satisfactorily both on verbal and non-verbal tasks. Specifically, she performs exceptionally well and exceeds expectations on tasks that involves perceptual abilities.
