Recommendation

I have known Ken Edward P. Falcon since he was in Grade 7, as we were both involved in the Supreme Secondary Government, now known as the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG). Throughout the years, I have had the opportunity to witness his growth as a student leader and his willingness to serve not only within our school but also in the wider community. In 2022, we were both involved in our school's Community Extension Services, where we extended assistance, including gifts and other forms of support, to children and elderly members of the community.
