III. PRESENTING PROBLEM:

Mark Aivan Q. Dacera is an incoming first-year nursing student at PHINMA Cagayan de Oro College who aspires to pursue higher education and eventually contribute to the improvement of his family's living condition. However, the family is currently experiencing financial constraints that may hinder her ability to continue her studies.

IV. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Mark Alvan Q. Dacera, an 18-year-old male, is the second child among the three children of Mr. Lolito V. Dacera and Mrs. Levie Q. Dacera. He is a resident of Purok 1, Barangay Roxas, San Isidro, Surigao del Norte. His family is an active beneficiary of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps), which provides conditional cash assistance to help support the educational and health needs of the children. Despite this assistance, the family's limited income remains inadequate to meet their daily needs.

Mark has consistently demonstrated academic excellence throughout his educational journey. He has been a consistent honor student from elementary to senior high school. He completed his elementary education at Roxas Elementary School, his junior high school education at Roxas National High School, and his senior high school education at Siargao National Science High School, where he also served as a Campus Journalist for the school's official publication. His active involvement in campus journalism reflects his leadership, communication skills, and commitment to extracurricular activities alongside his academic pursuits.

He is an incoming first-year college student who will pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at PHINMA Cagayan de Oro College. His academic achievements and active participation in school organizations demonstrate his dedication, perseverance, and commitment to excellence. With his strong academic foundation and determination to succeed, he aspires to complete his degree, become a competent healthcare professional, and contribute meaningfully to the well-being of his family and community through compassionate and quality healthcare service.

Despite his academic potential, Mark's family faces significant financial challenges. His father earns an estimated monthly income of only ₱3,000.00 as a farmer, while his mother occasionally contributes approximately ₱1,500.00 through small household-related income-generating activities. Their combined monthly income of approximately ₱4,500.00 is insufficient to cover the family's basic necessities, much less the increasing costs of higher education, including tuition, school supplies, transportation, board and lodging, and other educational expenses.

Notwithstanding these financial constraints, Mark remains determined to pursue his college education. He recognizes that earning a college degree will provide him with better employment opportunities and enable him to improve his family's quality of life. His perseverance, responsibility, and commitment to achieving his educational goals are evident in his consistent academic performance and positive outlook toward his future.

Considering the family's socio-economic condition and Mark's exemplary academic record, he is highly deserving of scholarship assistance. Financial support would significantly ease the family's economic burden and provide Mark with the opportunity to pursue and complete his Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Such assistance would serve as a valuable investment in his future, empowering him to achieve his aspirations and eventually give back to his family and the community through his knowledge, skills, and service.

V. ASSESSMENT:

Based on the interview and assessment conducted, the Dacera family belongs to a low-income household with limited financial resources. Their primary source of income from farming is insufficient to support the educational needs of their children while meeting the family's basic necessities.

Mark demonstrates a strong desire to continue his education and understands the value of completing a college degree. His willingness to pursue higher education despite financial hardships reflects his determination, responsibility, and commitment to improving his future. However, without financial assistance, he may face difficulty enrolling in or completing his college studies.

Given the family's socio-economic condition, Mark is considered a deserving recipient of scholarship assistance. Providing educational support would significantly lessen the financial burden on the family and increase his opportunity to finish college successfully.

VI. RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, it is respectfully recommended that **Mr. Mark Alvan Q. Dacera** be considered for **Scholarship Assistance**. Financial support for his educational expenses, including tuition fees, school supplies, transportation, board and lodging, and other necessary school-related costs, will greatly assist him in pursuing and completing his degree in Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Considering that he belongs to a **Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiary family**, the grant of scholarship assistance will complement the government's existing support by addressing the financial gap in his tertiary education. This assistance will not only benefit Mark personally but will also contribute to the long-term improvement of his family's socio-economic condition by empowering him to complete his education, secure stable employment, and become a productive member of society in the future.
